



2023-A Florida Insurance Guaranty Association Emergency Assessment

July 31, 2023

Citizens will begin collecting the 2023-A Florida Insurance Guaranty Association (FIGA) emergency [assessment](#) as ordered by the Office of Insurance Regulation (OIR). This will apply to all new and renewal business effective October 1, 2023, through September 30, 2024.

The assessment factor is .01 (or 1.0%) and will have a minimum charge of \$1.

Note: The 2023 FIGA Assessment, which was implemented on January 1, 2023, will expire on December 31, 2023.
